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## WorkKeys Assessment

The WorkKeys Assessment is a standardized assessment administered by WorkOne Bloomington of the Indiana Department of Workforce Development. This assessment establishes a WorkKeys Profile of an individual's skill set. An applicant must meet the IU Facility Operations minimum WorkKeys Assessment scores in all three areas for the Elevator Mechanic Apprenticeship to be considered for further participation in the selection process.

The following table lists the minimum WorkKeys assessment scores:

### Trade: Elevator Mechanic

WorkKey	Minimum Score = Entry Level
Applied Mathematics (AM)	5
Applied Technology (AT)	4
Locating Information (LI)	5
Reading for Information (RI)	5

You are responsible for registering online and scheduling your WorkKeys assessment. Assessments are an all-day event and are administered on four different days only. Assessments must be completed and scores on file with WorkOne by the end of the job closing date **June 15, 2017**). Assessments are held at WorkOne Bloomington. **NOTE: The assessment will last several hours.**
